KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, ~~Ed~~ Hogan, Ira D. Hogan and Charles W. Wessel, having mutually agreed to associate ourselves together in manner and purpose to become a Corporation, do hereby form a Corporation, under the Laws of the State of Montana, with the power and authority to establish, maintain, conduct and manage the business, enterprises and industries, and do the acts and things in these Articles of Incorporation set forth, and to do all the things incidental thereto, and do hereby certify; -

First; - That the name of said Corporation is, THE NATIONAL LAUNDRY COMPANY.

Second; - That the purposes for which said Corporation is formed, are as follows; -

A. To transact a commercial, mercantile and industrial business by washing, cleaning and pressing, for cash, all kinds of clothing, wearing apparel, household linen, draperies, curtains, and other fabrics, partially by hand, but principally by means of implements and machinery especially constructed and adapted for laundry work and operated by means of steam power, electric power, hand power or any kind of power.

And to carry on and conduct a steam and hand laundry, and laundry, and laundry business, and buy, sell, exchange and do whatever may be necessary in connection therewith, or in anywise pertaining thereto.

B. To construct and operate canals, ditches, flumes, dams, and other means of utilizing water for milling, irrigation, power, transportation and useful purposes.

C. To purchase, hold, pay out, develop, lease, deal in or otherwise use or dispose of lands, patented or otherwise, and townsites or towns or the lots, blocks or sub divisions thereof, in any town, village or City.

- D. To buy, sell, exchange and deal in all kinds of merchandise and personal property.
- E. To buy, sell, exchange and deal in real estate, houses, and buildings, lots, blocks and ranches.
- F. Said Corporation shall have power to own, control, vote and sell shares of stock in other Corporations, and can purchase and hold as Treasury stock, stock in this Corporation, and may sell and dispose of the same but cannot vote such stock.
- G. Said Corporation may carry on its business and operations in Great Falls, Cascade County, Montana, and at any other place or places in said County of Cascade, Montana, or State of Montana, or outside of said State.
- H. Said Corporation may borrow money and secure the payment of the same by note or notes, and mortgage liens upon its real estate or plant or any part thereof in such amounts, for such a time and at such rate of interest as its Board of Directors shall determine.
- I. Said Corporation may act as Agent, Trustee, Broker or in any other fiduciary capacity, and in general to do and perform acts and things and to transact such business in connection with the foregoing objects not inconsistent with law.

Third;- The name of the Town or locality, and County and State in which the principal office and place of business of said Corporation is located, and the place where its principal business is to be transacted, is the City of Great Falls, Cascade County, Montana.

Fourth;- The term for which said Corporation is to exist shall be Forty (40) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth;- The number of Director's of said Corporation shall be three (3), and the names and residences of those who are appointed and shall manage the business and concerns of said Corporation for the first three months, and until their successors are duly elected and qualified, are as follows;-

Ira D. Hogan, residing at Great Falls, Montana.

Charles M. Wessel, residing at Great Falls, Montana.

Sixth;- The amount of the capital stock of said Corporation shall be Thirty Thousand (\$30000.00) Dollars, divided into Twelve Hundred (1200) Shares, of the par value of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars.

Seventh;- That the amount of said Capital Stock which has been actually subscribed is Thirty Thousand (\$30000.00) Dollars, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, to wit;-

Eighth;- The stock of said Corporation shall be non assessable.
