

1 A RESOLUTION ADVANCING THE TOWN OF GLASGOW, MONTANA, FROM A TOWN  
2 TO A CITY OF THE THIRD CLASS.

3 WHEREAS, it manifestly appears to the Town Council of the Town  
4 of Glasgow, Montana, from the last Federal census, taken in the year  
5 nineteen hundred ten, that the Town of Glasgow has a population of  
6 one thousand one hundred fifty-eight (1,158), being the requisite  
7 population to entitle it, under the laws of the State of Montana,  
8 to be classified as a city of the third class, therefore:

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GLASGOW, MONTANA:

10 That the Town of Glasgow, Montana, be, and is hereby declared, ad-  
11 vanced from a Town to a City of the third class, as is provided  
12 by law.
