RESOLUTION No.1.

A RESOLUTION TO ADVANCE THE TOWN OF WHITEFISH, FROM A TOWN TO A CITY OF THIRD CLASS.

Be it Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Whitefish: That, Whereas, it manifestly appears to the Town council of the Town of Whitefish, Montana, from the last federal census of 1910, that the Town of Whitefish, Montana, has a population of less than 5,000 and more than 1,000 ~~population~~ population, And whereas, in accordance with Sections 3447, and 3448 of the Revised Codes of Montana, 1907, it appears that such Town of Whitefish must be so advanced from the class of a Town.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Whitefish, Montana.

1. That the Town of Whitefish, Montana, be and the same is hereby advanced to a City of the Third Class in accordance with the laws and statutes made and provided.
2. That a certified copy of this resolution be filed in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder in and for the County of Flathead.
3. That a certified copy of this resolution be filed in the office of the Secretary of State, at Helena, Montana.
4. That the first election of officers of the new municipal corporation, herein created, shall be held at the regular annual election of officers to be held in the year 1912.

Finally passed and approved this 22nd day of March 1911.
