A RESOLUTION ADVANCING THE TOWN OF CONRAD, MONTANA, TO A CITY OF THE THIRD CLASS.

Be It Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Montana:

Section 1. That whereas it appears from the special census of the Town of Conrad, Montana, taken by I. S. Martine under the direction of the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Montana, that the said Town of Conrad contains more than one thousand and less than five thousand inhabitants, thereby containing the requisite population to be advanced to a City of the Third Class.

Section 2. That in accordance with Section 3448, Chapter Four, Part Four, Title three, of the Revised Codes of Montana of 1907, that said Town of Conrad, Montana, be and the same is hereby, advanced to a City of the Third Class.

Section 3. All ordinances, by-laws, or resolutions in conflict with this resolution, are hereby expressly repealed.
