

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
THE FIRST EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF
GLASGOW, MONTANA

WHEREAS the members of the FIRST EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH of Glasgow, Montana, at a meeting held Monday Sept. 30, 1912 called for the purpose of incorporating themselves under the acts of the legislature of the State of Montana and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 4226 Revised Code of 1907 of the General Laws of the State of Montana, adopted with a unanimous vote the following resolution:

Resolved that the Trustees of this Church to-wit: Elmer Johnson, Haakon Larson, E. E. Aune, T. A. Hauge and J. W. Wedum be and are hereby authorizing to incorporate this church and for that purpose to file with the proper officer Articles of Incorporation as required by Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, know all men that we the said Trustees of the above named congregation, to-wit: Elmer Johnson, Haakon Larson, E. E. Aune, T. A. Hauge and J. W. Wedum in pursuance of attached resolution adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be THE FIRST EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF GLASGOW, MONTANA.

ARTICLE 2

The purpose of this corporation shall be to establish and maintain an EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH and to provide a place of public worship for the same in Glasgow, Montana; to establish, maintain and conduct schools for religious instructions of the young and to further other religious and charitable work, and to that end may adopt and establish by-laws and make all rules and regulations deemed necessary and expedient for the management of its affairs, in accordance with law and not inconsistent with these articles of incorporation and to take, manage, hold and dispose of the property, real and personal of said corporation.

ARTICLE 3

All persons who have been baptized and who received and adhere to the canonical books of Old and New Testaments as the Revealed Word of God, and the only rule of faith and life, and to the confessions of the EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH, especially the unaltered Augsburg Confessions and the Luthers small Catechism, as the correct and faithful exposition of the Divine Word, may become members of this corporation.
