

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

LAKE VIEW CEMETERY ASSOCIATION OF VALIER MONTANA.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY:

I. That on the twenty third day of March, A. D. 1912, the following persons, being residents of Valier, Teton County, Montana, met together at Valier, Montana, for the purpose of organizing a Cemetery Association, in Valier, Teton County, Montana: John E. Sparling, David F. Mains, Horace C. Paige, Charles A. Smith, William L. Campbell, William L. Bullock, Carlton H. Kester, Daniel S. Hunter, Frank A. Weismantel, Robert L. Dewar, Henry O. Burton, Frank A. Long, David L. Fulton, Wilson E. Fleming, Harris D. Harrison.

II. That upon a majority vote by ballot, William L. Bullock was elected Secretary of the Meeting ; and David F. Mains was by a majority vote by ballot elected Chairman of the Meeting.

III. That upon a majority vote, it was decided that the name of the Association, should be as follows: LAKE VIEW CEMETERY ASSOCIATION OF VALIER, MONTANA.

IV. That upon a majority vote it was decided that the number of Trustees for the Association should be five.

V. That, by ballot, the following persons were elected Trustees: David F. Mains, William L. Bullock, Frank A. Weismantel, John E. Sparling and Wilson E. Fleming.

VI. That the President and Secretary above named immediately, by lot, determined that the said Trustees be and were divided into the following classes: Wilson E. Fleming, Class One, to serve one year; Frank A. Weismantel and William L. Bullock, Class Two, to serve two years; John E. Sparling and David F. Mains, Class Three, to serve three years.

VI. That the Fourth Saturday of March of each year was determined by a majority vote of all present as the date for the annual election of Trustees.

VII. That it was determined by a majority vote of all present that all elections of trustees should be by ballot, and from among those qualified for such office as set forth in the Laws of the State of Montana in such cases made and provided.
