KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, residents of Yellowstone County, Montana, whose postoffice address is Worden, Montana, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Montana and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected as hereinafter set forth, a religious corporation, to be known as BETHLEHEM GERMAN CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH. For that purpose we do hereby certify:

1. That the name of said corporation is BETHLEHEM GERMAN CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH.

2. That the purpose for which such corporation is formed is to establish a church on the Huntley Project, in Yellowstone County, near Worden, Montana, for the purpose of public worship and religious training, to take charge of the church building, lots, estate and property and affairs of the temporalities thereof, to take and hold by purchase, gift, devise or bequest both real and personal property and to use and dispose thereof for the purposes for which this corporation is organized.

3. That said corporation shall have continuous succession under Section 4226 of the Revised Codes of Montana, 1907, as amended by Chapter 101 of the laws of 1909.

4. That the number of trustees for the first year of the corporate existence of such corporation shall be three, but may be increased by said incorporation so as not to exceed thirteen. The names of the trustees selected for the first year are Jacob Henry, Henry Hess and Henry Batt, whose postoffice address

19 said meeting.

20 On motion duly made and seconded, the President and Secretary
21 of said meeting were authorized and directed to certify to a copy
22 of said resolution for the purpose of annexing the same to the
23 Articles of Incorporation of said church.
